** Choose one math activity each day **

<p>Play "I Spy" with shapes around your house. Look for triangle, squares, circles, and rectangles.</p>	<p>Use beans, cereal, or paper clips as counters. Count the objects to get a total.</p>	<p>Go on a shape hunt! Find shapes outside. (triangle, square, rectangle, circle)</p>	<p>Look at a number and jump that many times. https://cliengagefamily.org/jump-to-the-number/</p>	<p>Write numbers from 1 to 9 on a piece of paper. Find sets of items and match them with each number.</p>
<p>Go on a color hunt outside. Find something that is red, yellow, orange, blue, green, and purple.</p>	<p>Use blocks, plastic cups, or other household items to build a structure. Count the number of items you used to build the structure.</p>	<p>Use toys or things you have at your house to make a pattern.</p>	<p>Using counters like beans or cereal, make a set of three and a set of five. Ask which set has more. Repeat with different sets of objects.</p>	<p>Do jumping jacks while counting to 10. Repeat!</p>
