

COVID-19 DECISION TREE

KNOWN EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

Does student/staff exhibit at least **one** of the bulleted symptoms that *are not within normal baseline of the individual*:

- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- Persistent Cough
- Fever 100 or higher/feeling feverish/chills

Or, does student/staff exhibit at least **two** of the bulleted symptoms that *are not within normal baseline of the individual*:

- Nausea/Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Muscle/Body Aches
- Sore Throat
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Runny or Stuffy Nose/Congestion

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STOP

Student/Staff exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19 will be DENIED ENTRY and/or ISOLATED until dismissed.

Student/Staff will be advised to seek advice of healthcare professional (HCP).

Received other diagnosis from HCP (norovirus, strep throat, etc.) that explains the symptoms, then staff may return after 24 hr fever free with no medication and symptoms improving

Received lab test for COVID-19

Continue to quarantine and monitor symptoms

COVID Negative

Stay home until fever free for 24 hr. without medication and symptoms improving

COVID Positive (including asymptomatic)

Stay home until*:

1. 10 days since positive diagnosis (COVID confirmed) or symptom onset (no medical evaluation) **AND**
2. No fever for 24 hr. without medication **AND**
3. Symptoms are improving.

COVID-19 symptoms without medical evaluation

*IMPORTANT:

- For any + test (symptomatic or asymptomatic) inform the campus principal (students) or supervisor (staff) & Theresa Burns (staff)**. Compile list of probable close contacts (6ft or less for total of 15 min without masks).

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
